ABOUT THE GLOBAL FORUM ON TB VACCINES

The Global Forum on TB Vaccines is the world's largest gathering of stakeholders striving to develop new vaccines to prevent TB. Held every two to three years, it provides an important and unique opportunity to review the state of the field, share the latest research findings, and identify new and innovative approaches to TB vaccine R&D, with the end goal of developing and deploying new TB vaccines as quickly as possible.

The Global Forum on TB Vaccines brings together a wide range of stakeholders from different constituency groups with a broad range of research interests. It has grown from 200 participants at the 2nd Global Forum in Tallinn to nearly 350 participants from 31 countries at the 5th Global Forum in New Delhi.

VIRTUAL GLOBAL FORUM

Due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, a Virtual Global Forum on TB Vaccines will be convened from 20 – 22 April 2021. It will be a focused event with several presentation and panel format sessions. The Virtual Global Forum will emphasize the theme of “*Advancing TB vaccines in the time of COVID-19*” and will provide an overview of the state of the field and recent progress in TB vaccine R&D against the backdrop of the COVID-19 pandemic. As with previous Global Forums, the Virtual Global Forum will convene researchers, developers, funders, policymakers, advocates, and other stakeholders remotely to discuss opportunities and challenges for TB vaccine R&D in these unprecedented times.

Although the decision to host a virtual Global Forum in 2021 was necessitated by the challenges of COVID-19, we welcome the opportunity that this virtual format will provide to expand participation and engagement in the Global Forum, now and in the future.

COVID-19

We recognize that there are uncertainties regarding the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on future in-person convenings. The Global Forum organizers are monitoring the COVID-19 situation closely and will adapt plans for the 6th Global Forum as we have a better understanding of the situation in the coming months. Options for a hybrid event are being considered, and planning is being undertaken such that the 6th Global Forum can be transitioned to a fully virtual event if necessary while still maintaining the high-quality information exchange that participants value.
